## Summer Bootcamp for Teachers

Free of charge

In the same spirit as the monthly workshops, the bootcamp is organised in partnership with the French Embassy and the Department of Education and Skills. This 4-day training session (24 hours) is the best option for teachers who want to follow a professional training without travelling too far, or for those who did not avail of the bursary to go to France during the summer. The bootcamp is also free of charge but is limited to 15 people. So don't wait too long to register!
