INTERNAL RULES OF THE GAME-CONTEST *LA PETITE NUIT DES IDÉES 2021*

Article 1: Rules

Alliance Française Dublin, whose head office is at 1 Kildare Street, Dublin 2, organises a number of competitions during the year, free and accessible to all, on the site www.alliance-francaise.ie.

These regulations define the legal rules applicable to the selected competition. The information given to user-participants on the screen on the progress of the competition completes these rules.

Article 2: Participation

This competition is open to minors from 4 to 12 years old (2 categories: 4 to 8 years old / 9 to 12 years old) residing in Ireland. However, it is imperative that a minor who wishes to participate in the competition, participates through his parents. By "parents" we mean the person or persons with parental authority over the minor (father and / or mother, or legal representative). Any participation of a minor is therefore carried out under the full responsibility of the holder(s) of parental authority.

Since the presentations of the creations take place on the online Zoom application, parents can decide whether or not to activate their video camera to avoid any relative issue related to image rights. The Zoom application allows you to share the screen or present the works without infringing the right to the image. **If the parents decide to activate the camera, we ask you to send us the document "Parental authorization to use the image of a minor child", to library@alliance-francaise.ie.** Without this document, we cannot accept your participation with an active camera.

Article 3: Duration

From 08/01/2021 to 28/01/2021, Alliance Française Dublin will be offering the competition for *La Petite Nuit des Idées* on its website www.alliance-francaise.ie.

The participant through his parents will be invited to identify himself or to create a member account by indicating his surname, his first name, his full postal address, and his e-mail address. This information will be important for the day of the competition, allowing us to send you all the information relating to the event as well as the links to the online video.

From 08/01/2021, you will therefore have 20 days to compose your works.

Article 4 - Designation of winners

The competition involves the creation of an artistic work under specific evaluation criteria:

- Quality of creation
- Originality of the idea
- Sophistication of the work
- Coherent expression of the idea.

The level in French will not be judged in this competition. The important thing is to try to express yourself in French.

The selection of the winners will be made directly after the presentation of the creations. The jury will have 5 minutes to deliberate on its choice. Participants will be placed in the Zoom waiting room. They will then be reintegrated into the live video online and the jury will give them the results of their deliberation. Jury's decision is final.

Article 5 - Prizes

There will have three prizes for each session:

1. The first prize is one **Alliance Française Dublin French course and a mug.**
2. The second prize is **one French Library Membership and a mug.**
3. The third prize is a **French book and a mug.**

In any event, Alliance Française Dublin cannot be held responsible for an incident occurring during the use of the prize / or resulting from a manufacturing defect in the prize and / or the consequences of a cancellation.

In addition, Alliance Française Dublin cannot under any circumstances bear the costs associated with the use of the prize, which remain the responsibility of the participant.
